Spoke at 7 countries including CERN, ASEAN Headquarters, IITs and IIM and many more Satyarup Siddhanta is an Indian Mountaineer who is currently holding the Guinness world record for being the youngest in the world to have climbed the highest mountains of all the seven continents (7summits) and the highest volcanoes of all the seven continents (volcanic 7 summits). Satyarup has skied the last degree to South Pole and is gearing up for the last degree skiing in North Pole the coming April. Jan 2023, Satyarup became the fastest Indian to summit one of the toughest technical peaks – Mt Nelion of Mt Kenya in Kenya. Satyarup got the rarest opportunity to take part in country's first ever civilian-military adventure activities in 2022 by Eastern Command. ASEAN entrusted Satyarup & his team the mission to take the ASEAN flag, the Indonesia Flag and the India flag to the summit of Mt Carstensz Pyramid as a commemorative climb to mark the 50th Anniversary of ASEAN and 25th anniversary of Dialogue with India.

Satyarup is also a motivational speaker where he ignites young minds through his inspiring journey from being an asthmatic to a world record holder mountaineer. He has delivered speeches in 7+ countries at various platforms, at corporates and conferences in the likes of ASEAN headquarters, Jakarta, CERN, Geneva, INFN, Italy, TEDx platforms and many.

Satyarup conducts leadership retreats on the mountains and take people from multi-disciplinary, multi culture and different social backgrounds to places like Sandakphu, Everest Base Camp, Kilimanjaro and helps them experiencing breakthrough through his unique program.

COVID CARE NETWORK

Satyarup is the founding Secretary of Covid Care Network Society. Covid Care Network has been registered as a society under the Provisions of West Bengal Societies Registration Act 1961 as a Non-Government Organization (societies) framework of complementary action by a group of Counsellors, coordinators and health workers linked with Covid related sufferings that could be useful in integrated Covid care at the community level.

Work so far:

- Setup 8 Covid Care Centre in the structure of field hospital with 20 oxygenated beds in 5 districts
- Involved in creating a 24/7 helpline no for Kolkata, Howrah and Siliguri to offer counselling, consultation, information and home care to Covid patients for no cost to close to 50000 Covid affected people.
- Created a network of 800+ volunteers with 200+ medical students, interns, nursing stuff, Doctors, Covid winners and Covid associates spanning across 10+ districts
- 50+ seminars (onsite and online) on Covid Awareness.
- Had been Frontline warrior to create activism against Social Ostracization
- Coordinated Cultural team to organize street play (pathanatika) with content that spreads Covid awareness and to collapse the fallacies and myths attached to Covid.
- Planned and executed mass awareness program using innovative ways like cycle rally, tram, cycle expedition, mountaineering expedition, Durga Puja stalls and music performances
- Started the Mask Movement to raise awareness on wearing mask
- Created a Rapid Action Ambulance Service Team in collaboration with Government of West Bengal for COVID hospitalization
- Created a Rapid Action Plasma Team which aims to counsel, sensitize and to secure consent for plasma donation
- To ensure Community preparedness for Covid situation in districts, mobilized self sustained team involving people from various genres and background for 10 districts
- Created editorial publications with focused team to provide information regarding Covid hospitalization, testing and accessing essential services
- Dialogue session and discussions regarding various topics like Herd Immunity, Vaccines, Plasma Therapy, Oxymeters, Masks, Disposal of medical wastes etc
- Created Mobile teams integrating representations from Local clubs, bodies, and NGOs and citizen representation whose aim to wear PPE Kits and visit the houses of Asymptomatic and mildly symptomatic patients in home isolation to check the oximeter reading and to establish means for getting essential services like food, sanitization etc
- Created a dedicated helpline for the project Alo an initiative to improve the mental health for the covid affected families.
- Helped in setting up National Covid Memorial and Vaccine Access Initiative




